

OTHER TRAINING SCHEMES @PETC:-

Off late, during 2011-12, PETC has emerged as a Training Centre, for not only Competitive Examinations, but also all other training schemes of the Social Welfare Department, being implemented under the SCSP sector, such as Nursing & Paramedical Courses; Pilot training, Airhostess & Hospitality management, NIFT, CIPET, etc and also scholarships to candidates pursuing higher studies abroad. The details of the training schemes implemented during 2011-12 are as follows-

NURSING COURSES- Online applications are called during the month of August-September every year. During 2011-12, for the 1st time, online applications & online selection of Institutions was introduced successfully. **3269**-candidates were offered seats for GNM nursing & 151 candidates for B.Sc Nursing. The eligibility for B.Sc nursing is a minimum of 40% marks in II PUC Science, & GNM nursing is a min of 35 % marks in II PUC Arts/Commerce/Science. The selection of candidates is through merit obtained in their II PUC exam.



The list of Nursing Schools/Colleges are given by the Directorate of Medical Education, & classified into A,B,C & D categories, based on the quality of facilities, infrastructure, attachment to Medical college hospital etc. This list is uploaded into the online application & selection of nursing courses & colleges is done by the candidates while submitting the online application only. Final allotment of seats is based on the individual merit cum choice of schools/colleges.

PARAMEDICAL COURSES: -



Applications are called during the month of September- October, every year. During the year 2011-12, for the first time 412 candidates were offered seats for paramedical courses such as diploma in X-ray technology, operation Theatre technology, ophthalmic technology, medical laboratory technology, dental mechanics, and dialysis technology. The eligibility for these courses is either II PUC Sciences (2 yrs) & S.S.L.C (3 yrs). The selection process for these courses is first through submission of online application, followed by a state level counseling, based on merit obtained in II PUC or SSLC.

SCHOLARSHIPS TO STUDY ABROAD: -



In this scheme, SC/ST candidates with a monthly income not exceeding Rs.25000/-, are provided scholarship to pursue higher studies in foreign Universities. Here, the Govt. pays the complete fee, maintenance allowance, expenditure for books, to & fro airfare etc. Selection of candidates is done by a Selection Committee, under the Chairmanship of the Principal Secretary to Govt. Dept. of Social Welfare.
